"It's safe to say that a year ago, there was almost no overlap between the Quora community and The Seniors Center community. Today, Quorans are learning about the importance of protecting our Social Security Trust Fund, and Senior Citizens are being exposed to a whole range of new information. It's been a very positive relationship," Perrin said
